Grameen Vikas Evam Takniki Kendra is a non government and non political voluntary organization. GVSTK was legally registered under Rajasthan Societies registration Act 1958 in 1994. Its registration number is 16 – 94 -85 /1994-1995. It was established by working in association with some like minded organizations & government programs.

The NGO has started its work in the development sector since 30 years. GVSTK is working for development activities in Ajmer & Tonk district in Rajasthan especially in area of education , health , sanitation , women empowerment , environment, fundamental rights and cultural art promotion in rural area for provide basic facilities to rural communities . The organization believes in promoting village institution and strengthening their activities on the issue of concerning to live at all levels . Presently GVSTK is addressing 60 villages in Ajmer and Tonk District of Rajasthan

Women's action for virtual Empowerment (WAVE) –

GVSTK has been implementing WAVE project since 2018 supported by Share & Care Foundation through various activities as – issue identification, village level leadership, mobilization, group forming, health, social security schemes and felt needs.

During the project period , Trained peer Leader (1 young rural women at each village) and peer educators (2 rural women and 2 adolescent girls at each village) have been identified

within their own villages. 05 peer leader/ educators have been also identified as peer group of other 15 rural women/ girls from their village. So, total 15 peer leaders and 75 peer educators have been address other 300 rural women and girls at all 15 villages.

On 5 July 2021 a training conducted to increase concept among women's & peer leaders, educators on project feedback. They were imparted knowledge on Role & responsibility of leaders, educators on Self security, gender equality, Sensitization, Women rights and role of peer leader & educators. In the program 19 Peers Leaders , educators were participated actively during Members of Teachers , media Elected representatives , Anganwadi Worker, Local News paper agent etc.

Orientation program conducted on 10 Dec. 2022 for peer leaders to implement the project activities on village level. The aware on project related work, objectives, activities, women health, livelihood and their rights. Resource person Munna Lal Rao trained to participants on leadership quality in development and organized process .

Leadership training was organized on 30 Dec. 2022 for the Peer Educators for project details and program implementation, in which information about activities, village organization, women health, livelihood and leadership development were trained In the program, 75 women and adolescents participated as a peer group from 15 villages and the future strategy and direction was decided. All Peer Groups took the responsibility of organizing village level meetings in 15 villages.

Network meeting conducted on dated 15 Dec. 2022 at BCMHO, CHC office Malpura . ASHA, AWW, Peer leaders & educators were participated in the meeting. Collective discussed on



health issues like as – women health, vaccination, distance of medical facilities, rural health issues, health related schemes and further action process. Mr Kanhaiya puri presented efforts by GVSTK, Pachewar on various social issues and current project.

BCMHO Mr. Dr. Sanjeev chaudhary discussed on GVSTK efforts on health issues and motivated for joint efforts on vaccination and other health issues to solve on the spot. They told to health worker for fully vaccination immunization in joint efforts with GVSTK and discussed to conduct health check up camp at villages level.

Monthly regular meetings organised In all 15 Villages with the help of community for better involvement & sustainability of project. During the meeting have been organized with groups for Awareness on Equality, Equity, Self Defence, women’s rights , social security schemes, livelihood issues among women & girls . Increased mindset of male community towards gender justice and collective action for rural development.



Rural women have been aware to protect themselves from violence at domestic and social levels . Rural women have been aware about the constitutional and legal rights for improving the standard at social- economical and political level . Imparted knowledge on balancing of income & expenditure and motivated to involve in livelihood training program. During the implementation , Time to time regular meeting have been conducted for evaluation of project activity , whether the project direction is going on right direction or not . Regular monitoring have been also done for check the project activity impact and outcomes .

Vaccination program –

Vaccination programme was implemented supported by Azim Premji Foundation . This programme has benefited 32 villages of Pachewar & Kalmunda PHC in Malpura block of Tonk distt. The key objective of this programme was to enhance awareness on of

'vaccination issue. GVSTK has conducted volunteers identification, orientation workshop, vaccination related data collection, training of leaders on this issue for Village/block level opinion leaders. ASHA Sahyoginis & AWWs had participated in this awareness drive. Vaccination camps organised in 11 selected villages of Pachewar & Kalmunda PHC,s. During the camps ANM, AWW, ASHA, PRI members, COVID worker, Ration dealers and like minded person were participated and 490 were vaccinated in the camps.



COVID -19 awareness -

Action for Safety of Humans from COVID – 19 Project implemented in 20 village of Malpura Block in Tonk district of Rajasthan supported by Share & Care Foundation. GVSTK organization have also been ensure the active participation of local structure , Like Doctors, ANM, Male Nurse, ASHA Worker, SDO, Police Station , NREGA Labours , Gram panchayat body , SHGs , Farmers , Youth boys, Women’s and adolescent Girls and active leaders of PRI members at every villages respectively . 20 meeting , Nukad Natak have been organized to mobilized the community for use of mask, sanitizer, soap and regular



hand washing. – Female participated from each village of project area. During the COVID 19 , In our working area most of the daily wage labours losses regular work, no work for handicapped person, women's loss of work in agriculture. Adolescent girl , back ward communities ,SC, ST & minority are directly affected by corona virus and nobody have work and jobs during this situation .In this situation our organization provided dry ration kit to affected communities in need based area .

Child trafficking –

We have associated with My Choices Foundation as consultative partnership since two year ago in Malpura block of Tonk District .



During the program conducted at every village in Malpura block of Tonk Distt. , Like Door to door contact , group dialogue on girls trafficking , discussion , survey for domestic violence , village meeting and to ensure the women approach with school for circulation of reading materials in all village school on child trafficking issues. School teacher were also share pamphlets to children's , communities and other person during the school hours at village level .

We have also been ensure the active participation of local structure , Like Police Station , NREGA Labors , Gram panchayat body , SHGs , Farmers , Youth boys and Girls and active leaders of PRI members at every villages respectively .

Progress Highlights

- ✓ Under the WAVE project, 75 women and adolescents were selected as Peer Leaders and Educators and oriented on project details . At present the Peer groups are organizing meetings in 15 villages.
- ✓ There has been an increase in the skills of Peer Groups (women's and adolescents) to work on women's development, Gender, livelihood, rights, social security schemes and rural issues.
- ✓ GVSTK was conferred with the award on 26 Jan. 2022 by the Sub Divisional Magistrate SDM , Malpura for his joint work with the government on health related fully Vaccine Immunization in villages. GVSTK was recognized in the field of health at district and state level.
- ✓ Vaccination camps organised in 11 selected villages of 2 PHC and 490 were vaccinated in the camps.
- ✓ 20 meeting , Nukad Natak have been organized to mobilized the community for use of mask, sanitizer, soap and regular hand washing. – Female participated from each village of project area .
- ✓ Hand over 200 Dry ration kit to affected families in 16 villages of Malpura block and 400 Health kit also hand over to Doctors, ANM, Male Nurse, ASHA Worker, hospital and Anganwadi centres for COVID safety .
- ✓ Awareness created on Child trafficking issues at schools, community and local places in Malpura block and almost 1500 were participated in the program.
